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**N.C. Transportation Museum to host
All-Mopar Car Show this Labor Day weekend**

SPENCER, N.C.— This Labor Day weekend, don't fight the beach traffic on the highway. Instead, take a day trip to the N.C. Transportation Museum for the Plymouth Car Club All-Mopar Car Show on Saturday, Sept. 2 from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m.

The show, organized by the Plymouth Carolina Region of the club and sponsored by Lake Norman Chrysler Jeep Dodge, and is open to all Plymouth, Chrysler, Dodge and Jeep model cars.

Registration is from 9 a.m. to noon, at a cost of \$15 per car, which includes a ticket for the on-site train ride. Club membership is not required to show a vehicle.

First and second place will be awarded in 11 classes, along with a Best of Show prize. The first 75 car owners will receive a dash plaque. Grab bags and door prizes will be awarded throughout the day, and owners can participate in a 50/50 drawing. Trophies will be awarded at 3 p.m.

Refreshments will be sold by Eastern Star. After checking out the show offerings and grabbing a bite to eat, visitors and show participants will also have plenty to do and see at the museum, including touring the museum's own collection of antique automobiles in the Bumper to Bumper exhibit. There is no charge for admission to museum exhibits.
